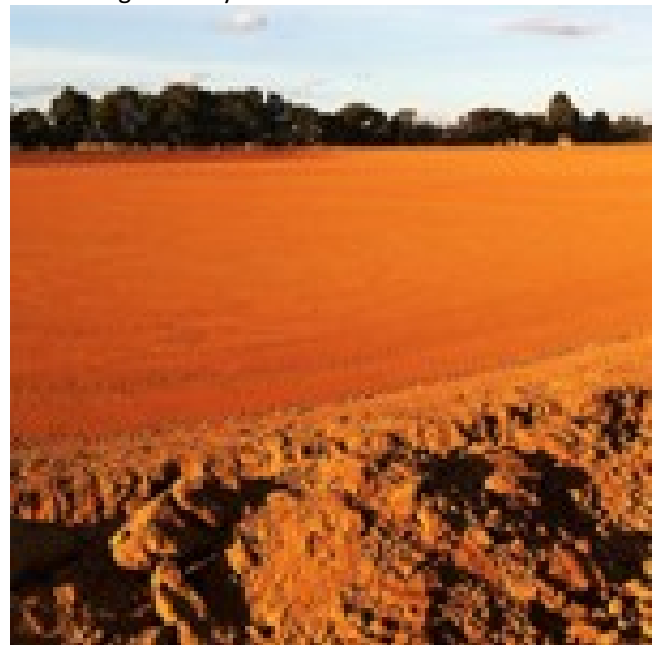

- Adopt a Farmer - Lockington: \$60k includes Rotarians and business donations spread over 3 years;
- Farmer Drought Relief - Uniting Church - Kyabram: \$13k, clothes and food;
- Bushfire Relief - \$3k;
- Camp Getaway - new kitchen: \$25k.
- Muscular Dystrophy: \$15k but with matching grant, \$30k;
- Essendon Keilor College - Underprivileged Students: \$5k, plus \$1k Centenary Celebrations.
